## Session 130

### GAME 327

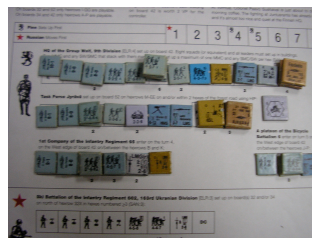

### GAME 328

The 2<sup>nd</sup> game of our 130<sup>th</sup> session was a scenario called **ASL 49 Piercing the Peel**. Holmstrom faced off against Chip Dickerson in this one. Bob took the Germans and attacked the Dutch who had a lot of wire and fortifications. There were a lot of low rolls on turn one, and a Dutch hero was created, and the German 9-1 was whacked by a sniper. In the end the Germans captured the 2 pillboxes for the win.
